WHERE: Moby's

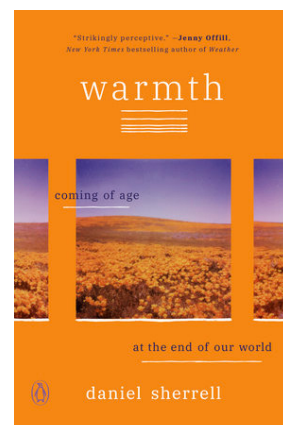
