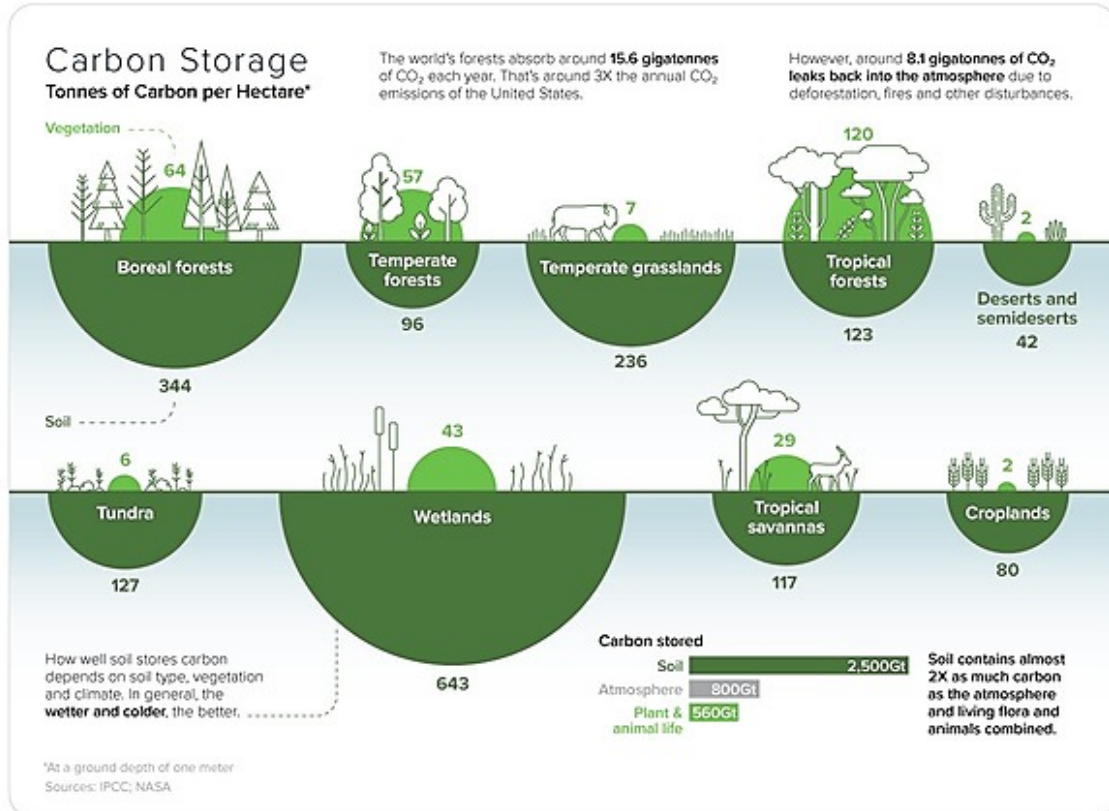
Carbon Storage in Earth's Ecosystems

Achieving net-zero by 2050 depends on the Earth's natural carbon sinks.

Forests play a critical role in regulating the global climate. They absorb carbon from the atmosphere and then store it, acting as natural carbon sinks.

Where is Carbon Stored?

There are various carbon pools in a forest ecosystem.



Carbon Storage in Earth's Ecosystems

Soils not only protect our water supplies and keep vegetation and trees resilient to drought, they also store significantly more carbon through organisms and fungi living in the soils than the above-ground organisms and plants! Our wetlands and marine estuaries can also contribute to restoring salmon populations and the orca. Double bonus!
